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Exhibitor Guidelines

Please complete the Exhibitor Registration Form, enclose a check for appropriate fees and mail to the address on page 1. Forms may also be e-mailed, if no fees are required. Space is limited and applications will be considered in the order they are received. You'll receive an email confirmation once you've been approved.



Hours of Operation

10 am – 4pm on Saturday, November 21, 2015. This is a rain or shine event. Vendors MUST have sandbags or weights to secure their tent, as the venue tends to get windy in the afternoon. NO STAKES PLEASE. Setup starts at 8 am. Exhibitors must be setup by 10 am and remain open until 4 pm.

Venue Location

From I -95 North and South via Butler Blvd:

Take Exit 344 (FL -202/ Butler Ave). Head east on Butler Blvd. to A1A North (3rd Street).

Make a left on A1A North, continue north until Beach Blvd. then turn right. Turn left at 2nd Street.

From Beach Boulevard:

East on Beach Blvd. (Hwy 90), cross 3rd Street (State Hwy A1A) to the ocean, and turn left at 2nd Street.

Fees

If you'd like to sell items of any kind, the vendor fee is \$75. There is no fee for organizations with educational displays and will not be selling items; please bring your own tent, table and chairs. Organizations selling items are still required to pay the vendor fee.

Payment

Payments will only be accepted by mail prior to the RWF. Checks are payable to **Sea to Shore Alliance** and should be mailed to: Sea to Shore Alliance, S2S Events - RWF, 4411 Bee Ridge Rd #490, Sarasota, FL 34233. Please allow 2-3 weeks for checks to be received and deposited. Upon registration and payment, you will receive an e-mail confirmation.

Raffle Items

Exhibitor Set-up

You will receive a site map prior to the event with your assigned spot. Each space is approximately 12' x 12' (room for a 10'x10' tent). Exhibitors are required to provide their own tent, table, chairs, linens, etc. Each exhibitor is required to keep their space and surrounding area clean and remove all trash at the end of the day. Recyclable waste must be deposited in the proper receptacles provided (plastic, aluminum, cardboard).

*There are a very limited number of pre-set spaces that include an 8' x 2' banquet table and tent coverage. This courtesy is provided to government partners and nonprofits not selling any items.
